 Operation solar is a new and extra way for Police to tackle hate crime, making better use of anonymous information and encouraging more people to report hate crime problems.















They laughed at him, carried on pushing and shoving.

This makes Richard feel very sad and upset and also makes it difficult for Richard to make friends as he has less confidence.


Richard has told a support worker at the centre about this and she has arranged a meeting with Richard and the two boys to talk about the problem.
